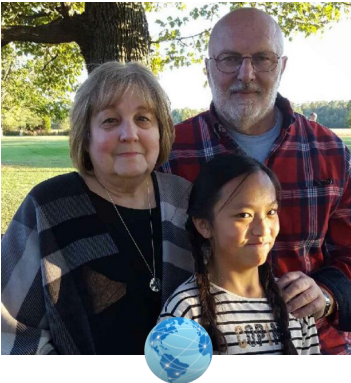

Pray that God would continue to strengthen the next generation of leadership, that they would be prepared to take over and expand the various ministries to internationals here.





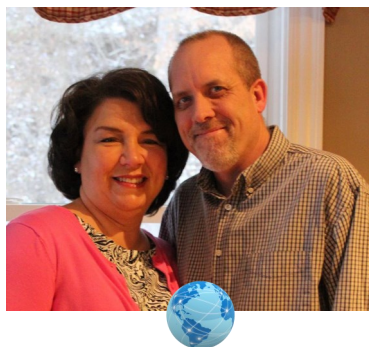

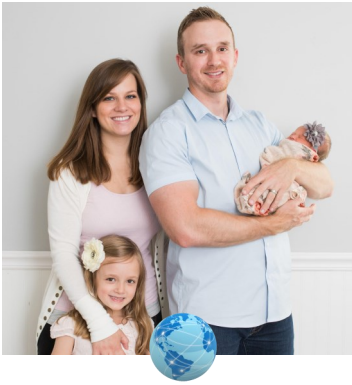
Pray for our staff and partners in places like India and Nepal, whose governments are becoming increasingly hostile towards Christians and the Gospel.

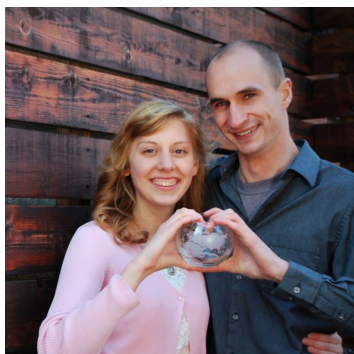

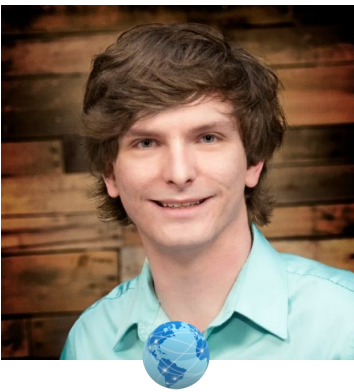
